Gayle has worked diligently to coordinate a plethora of of guest speakers from the Brandon and Westman area to speak to the group in guided monthly meetings. Speakers such as Dr. Ron Richert who counsels on grief, the AJAG, SISIP, OSISS, MFRC, Veterans Affairs, the BPSO, Elspeth Reid Resource Centre, and more have all provided these women with invaluable tools for their military life. Gayle is an excellent example of someone identifying a need and solving the problem proactively. Mrs. Raynor, also a military spouse herself, has ambitiously undertaken the job of providing all military wives with information and a venue where you can feel at home with all of the feelings felt during deployment.

Gayle is also responsible for the sponsorship fundraiser through Sobey's, where the yellow ribbon lawn signs were made available in a national chain of grocers to residents of Brandon and Westman at large.
