• In order to raise the awareness of Brandon Salutes and provide an opportunity for local businesses to show their support for military members and their families, a signage program including street banners and permanent signage was developed in 2004/2005. The street banners are located throughout the City and are continuously monitored with repairs undertaken as required; however no new banners will be sold from this point on. While the banners have served a very valuable purpose, there have been issues of longevity that has warranted discontinuation of the program.

 Utilizing funds raised through the Street Banner program and grants secured from other sources, three billboard signs have been erected – 1st Street and Veteran's Way; Highway 10 South and Highway 10 North.
